Gospel of Matthew 10:17-28

Courage!



American society has even recognized and appreciated the great policu contributions of Christianity to the culture and to society as a whole. The church did for free – important things benefitting society that didn't cost the government a dime! Things are changing rapidly now. We are considered evil, the bad guys – and Christians are foremost on that list of culprits!

The natural way of things in human societies around the globe would

be for Christ-followers to be hated enough to be persecuted! The natural way of things is for the followers of Jesus to be oppressed and suppressed by the leaders, the political and religious authorities of almost any society!



Jesus, Paul, others, all testified before governors and Kings, without the slightest softening of their position to *NOT* believe! But it was still God's purpose that witness of t/Gospel be given them personally.

1st objective - we want as many people as possible to hear and have opportunity.

2nd, our objective is to make people responsible for rejecting Christ if they so choose! They have freedom, but they also bear the responsibility!



- On that day of judgment, the God, the
- Judge, can say "*But you were told I sent people to you*.

Vs. 19 - Expectations are that we will be hunted down



and arrested! If they dont confine or kill us we will keep talking! If they confine us we will make

Christians of convicts. If they kill us, we profit by it, because then we

we will see Him, be with Him, be transferred *home*!

The truth is that while we worship Jesus in comfort here in

America, Christ-followers are getting arrested by the hundreds in China, and spending years of their lives in jail. In Russia the government is beginning to restrict the Bible-believing Christians and



outside pastors and teachers from coming into the country to teach and train Russian Christians. In many, if not most Muslim countries, sharing Christ is a capital offense! Jesus says that the Holy Spirit will give us the proper words to say if and when we are arrested and brought up before trial. The worst thing about trial is the intimidation factor. But Jesus says that courage will be



given by God – the intimidation factor will be a *non*-factor when it comes time to speak for Him.



There seems to be a common phenomena at work there. When our lives are held completely in the hands of others – and those "others" are hostile to us, then, it is time to just let

go. Letting go of our life and giving it over is always the point when the Holy Spirit takes over!

Jesus says that Christians in the future will have to endure the heartbreak of betrayal even within their own family! But family members don't betray family members



until they are convinced that their offending family member has done something very bad by converting to Christianity! The only way they would be convinced of that was if society was painting a very bad picture of Christians. Vs 24 – Jesus tells his disciples that just as he has been accused being evil they could expect society to do the same to them! I never expected it to happen in America – NEVER! But I've watched a steady erosion of sanity in this nation and much the Judeo-Christian



ethic/ideals has been reversed and continues to be.

Vs 28 – Jesus told His disciples that it was a natural regression

of societies everywhere. So it's happening here. Jesus says to be visible – to lay our lives on the line – to lay them *down* if necessary! We don't run away and become invisible! But not to be stupid about it so that we are easy to stamp out!



Don't be afraid of anyone! But be afraid of being unfaithful to Jesus and His mission. But hope is on *our* side, not theirs!
